

## Measures within the safety and hygiene concept

### Additional guidelines for stand construction

(Status: October 14, 2020)

To ensure that trade fairs and conferences can take place safely and successfully even during the coronavirus pandemic, Messe München and other Bavarian trade-fair companies have worked out a safety and hygiene concept, which was officially ratified by the [Bavarian state government](#) on 23 June 2020. This concept ensures that trade fairs and conferences can take place again since September 2020. Essentially, it is based on three topics:

- Social distancing
- Hygiene
- Traceability of all participants

The most important points include the general rule of 1.5 meters distance on the whole grounds. Where this distance cannot be maintained, and generally indoors, a mask is mandatory. The traceability of all participants is guaranteed by pre-registration and our admission system.

### General notices

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- The “[SARS-CoV-2 Occupational Safety Standard](#)” from the German Federal Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs is binding ([Federal Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs](#)).
- The official distancing and hygiene requirements apply at all times:
  - 1.5 m distance
  - Masks that cover the nose and mouth
  - Sneezing etiquette
  - Hand hygiene
- It is compulsory to wear a mask at all times during construction and dismantling.



## Construction and dismantling

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- All employees, service providers and stand builders of the exhibitors must be registered beforehand. Walking or driving around the exhibition center is not permitted without prior registration. The registration is available via the online ticket shop of the respective event.
- A documentation of the names and attendance times of employees, suppliers, service providers, external companies and independent employees working on stand construction is to be carried out independently. This ensures that contact persons can be quickly identified in the event of a corona infection.
- A hygiene concept for construction and dismantling must be created, printed out and brought to the stand. A person responsible for hygiene is to be named in the concept. You can find more detailed information in the "SARS-CoV-2 Occupational Safety Standard" (see general notices above).
- The trade fair-specific construction and dismantling times can be found on the respective trade fair website and in the traffic guidelines.

## Stand building / construction measures

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**There are no mandatory requirements for stand construction, for example no one-way street system or a limit on the number of visitors to the stand.**

### **Further information & recommendations:**

- The maximum number of visitors at an event is based on the size of the total event area and does not refer to the number of visitors at the stands.
- In principle, a mouth-nose cover must be worn on the stand area. This does not apply at the table, provided that the minimum distance of 1.5 metres can be safely maintained.
- The general rules on spacing should be taken into account when building stands, e.g. when planning meeting rooms or tables.
- It is recommended that meeting rooms are constructed with ceilings that are as high and open as possible to achieve complete ventilation.
- The food/ catering area must be clearly recognizable. The general rules for Bavarian catering establishments apply.
- For the catering area at the trade fair stand, the requirements that generally apply to catering must be fulfilled, e.g. protective plexiglas windows where food is collected.
